



Academic Teacher

This position requires a ministry-oriented academic instructor with a passion for excellence and a heart for troubled youth. This person must be motivated and organized, and he/she must have a genuine relationship with Christ.

1) Academics

- Provide instruction and as needed tutoring to students in the classroom.
- Coordinate services with Alpha-Omega Online Academy
- Supervision of students' academic progress and coursework.
- Coordination with sending and receiving educational institutions
- Management of classroom and fulfillment of basic academic duties
- Maintain a quality learning environment

2) Discipleship

- Provide spiritual leadership to students while also continually encouraging them toward personal growth.
- Minister to student needs as opportunities arise and/or during scheduled sessions.
- Staff should be able and prepared to lead students to Christ.

3) Student Supervision, Mentoring, and Interaction

- Supervision, mentoring, and interaction with residents during various activities, which may include but is not limited to school, breaks and free time, and recreational activities.
- Provide positive mentoring and encouragement
- Administering of discipline and correction according to Teen Challenge policies/procedures as is necessary.

4) Other: At times, staff members may be called upon to serve in areas not necessarily outlined in their formal job description.

- Bachelor's degree or higher (Master's degree preferred)
- Teacher certification
- General computer proficiency
- Solid organizational skills
- 30 hours of training in childcare or related field annually (Provided by Teen Challenge)
- Maintain First Aid and CPR certification (Certification training provided by Teen Challenge)
- Be trained in Crisis Intervention at least biannually (Provided by Teen Challenge)
- At least 21 years of age
- Mature and Godly character

- 75% of continuing education costs up to \$3,000 per year

Teen Challenge Adventure Ranch is a program and therapeutic boarding school for troubled teenage boys who struggle with issues such as: anger problems, oppositional and defiant attitudes, ADHD, drug and alcohol abuse, running away, delinquency, and other behavioral problems. We are not a “rehab,” but a discipleship ministry. It is through a relationship with Jesus Christ that our students find the power to transform their lives.

We have several elements that have contributed to our program’s success. Foremost is the fact that we are a Christ-centered program. We have seen even the most resistant boys’ lives transformed after they spend time in the loving Christian atmosphere that is present on our campus. We also offer the following elements as a part of our program:

- Daily chapel services
- Intervention & Discipleship Classes
- Outdoor adventure program (camping, hiking, rappelling, rock climbing, canoeing, etc.)
- Equine assisted therapy and horsemanship
- A structured environment
- An active recreational program
- Group sessions
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Private Christian school with fully accredited classes
- Vocational classes
- Tutoring and GED preparation

We have a 31-acre campus which is surrounded by the beautiful Ozark Mountains. We have multiple buildings on our property as well as a 14 element ropes course. Construction is currently underway for a 4 story zip line and rappel tower.

Our program is approximately 18 months long. The first 9-12 months are done in residence at Teen Challenge and the last 6 months take place after the child returns home and enters our aftercare program. We work hard to make the transition from program to home as smooth as possible, and we desire to see each family experience a deep level of healing and restoration.
